

What is the difference between the Accuplacer and the MELAB?

*The **Accuplacer** is used by 2-year colleges as a placement test. You can't fail, but you can be placed in lower level, non college credit courses.

*Scholarships will pay for the non credit college courses, but it will take you longer than two years to finish your degree or program.

*It is highly recommended that if you are placed in non college credit courses that you take free adult education classes and re-take the placement test at a later date.

*The **MELAB** is used by 4-year colleges to determine whether or not you are capable of attending. You can fail and not be admitted into that 4-year college. However, you can always go to a 2-year college.
