## Schedule of Programs

9:00 am - 11:30 am Introduction to Learning to Achieve: This session is <u>mandatory</u> and contains the core concepts to prepare you for your choice of one or both of the 2-hour afternoon sessions. Topics covered include the Definition of Learning Disabilities (LD), the importance of Self Determination in achieving goals, and an overview of Legal Issues, Confidentiality and Selfdisclosure relevant to providers working with adults with LD.

11:30 am - 12:30 pm Lunch on your own.

- 12:30 pm 2:30 pm Reading Disabilities: This session covers the considerations and strategies for working with adults with LD who struggle with reading. Activities include identifying the skills needed to be a successful reader, identifying characteristics of **Reading Disabilities (RD)**, and exploring the four common types of RD. Most importantly, you will become familiar with teaching strategies and practice methods using Explicit Instruction.
- 2:30 pm 4:30 pm Written Expression Disabilities: This session focuses on Learning Disabilities related to written expression. You will have the opportunity to review the two types of Written Expression Disabilities and their characteristics. You will learn how to identify appropriate accommodations for those who struggle with writing. Time will be devoted to practicing research-based instructional strategies.
