- Final notification on the status of your proposed workshop: **March**

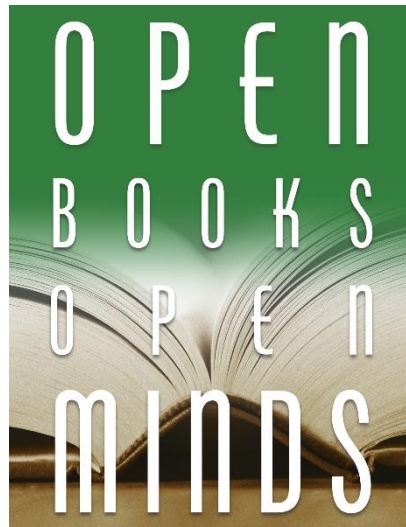




How to submit your application:
