

Connect2Compete Provides Free and Low Cost Internet Access for Low Income Families

Connect 2 Compete has created the [Everyone On Campaign](#) to help reach its goal. Everyone On is a three-year, multi-lingual campaign used to raise awareness of the digital divide issue and help provide people with both online and in-person digital literacy training. On the Everyone On site, you can also find where the nearest computer trainings occur in your area. Your organization might also want to make sure it's listed on this website by contacting Connect 2 Compete and giving them information about your program. However, Connect 2 Compete's value really comes from its partnerships with community-based organizations which allow affiliated low-income individuals to buy discounted computers and low-cost broadband access for their homes.

There are two ways to qualify for this program. When visiting the Connect 2 Compete website, you can check to see if your zip code is one which pre-qualifies you for these services. If this is the case, you can follow the instructions and review several options on which types of services you'd like to purchase.

FLC recently joined with Connect 2 Compete's national network of partners to help qualify low-income individuals for these services. If you don't live in a pre-qualified area, you may be granted access from a partnered nonprofit organization, such as FLC, by visiting that organization's specific Connect 2 Compete URL. These partnered organizations have been granted access to these services when their clientele is at least 70% low-income individuals. By working with FLC, your adult learners and their families can obtain high-speed internet and computers within their budget with the use of FLC's URL code.
