Working in partnership with California Library Literacy Services, FLC has been able to add to the selection of course videos that demonstrate tutoring strategies, modeling key approaches to reading instruction in areas such as alphabetics, vocabulary, reading comprehension and fluency. In addition to the roll out here in Florida, twenty California Library Literacy programs will be piloting the course starting this Fall.
