ONLINE ENGLISH CONVERSATION CLASSES

Join the inaugural group of volunteers for an exciting new statewide pilot project offering free ESOL conversation classes to adults with limited English skills.

The Florida Literacy Coalition, in collaboration with adult literacy programs throughout Florida, will be offering classes using the award-winning We Speak NYC curriculum. The online classes will take place using Zoom during regularly scheduled times throughout the week.

Instructors commit to the following:

- Leading an intermediate-level distance learning class of up to 20 adult English language learners for one 2-hour class per week for 8 weeks. You will be paired with a co-teacher.
- Using WSNYC pedagogy with free online materials.
- Attending two mandatory instructor training sessions on WSNYC pedagogy (see schedule below).
- Participating in three instructor meet-ups during the semester.
