

The software we are using for this program is WizIQ. This video is a brief introduction to the software.




Scheduling a Session

To schedule a session, follow these steps:

1. On the <u>virtual tutoring website</u>, click on the "schedule a session" button at the bottom of the home page.




2. Enter in the classroom login information given to you. If you do not have a login or have forgotten it, please contact Nicole at ncaban@floridaliteracy.org




3. Click "schedule a live class"



4. Set your desired date and time. If an error message pops up saying, that time is already scheduled, you can either **schedule a different time** or **use the backup classroom** assigned to you. Please make sure to put your last name in the title box.




- 5. IMPORTANT At the bottom on your class settings, you will see two options.
 - Record this class choose yes or no. Choosing "yes" will automatically record the class.
 - Allow attendees to enter class without signup CHECK OFF YES. If this is not done, it will force the student to sign up.



Launching your class


Ready to start? Simply click your session and click "launch class"


You will see a link below the "launch class" button. Please send this link to your learner, so they can also get into the class. They will be able to get in with just this link. They will not need to download any software!



Virtual Tutoring Classroom At-a-Glance


Here is a full view of the screen. You have the ability to share screens, talk face-to-face, share documents and more!





- These are annotation tools. Here you can draw, type and mark up your document.
- 2. This section will allow you to upload documents, access the content library, screen share and play videos
- 3. Clicking on the "+" will allow you to open another tab.

- This section is where you will see your class roster. You can also enable their cameras and mics here.
